Nature Photography Course, May 2012

If you want to get serious about nature photography, then this class is for you!

- **Instructor:** Joni L. James, Joni L. James Photography/HeronWatch Nature Programs
- **Course Description:** The course will cover various topics as they relate to nature photography. Each class will cover specific content such as exposure, depth of field, composition, equipment, lighting, wildlife, landscapes, macro work, etc. There will be classroom critiques of each participant's photography and, at the end of the course, an exhibit of the images produced by the participating photographers.
- **When:** Five Thursdays, May 3, 10, 17, 24, & 31 – 6:30 - 8:30 p.m., plus a Field Session on Saturday, May 19 – 9:00 - 11:00 a.m.
- **Where:** County Administration Building, 180 S. Main St., Martinsville 46151, Lucille Sadler Room (Thursday, May 10th class will be held at the Community Foundation of Morgan County—located on West side of downtown Martinsville Square)
- **Who:** Any Morgan County resident (ages 16 - Adult) who has a working knowledge of their camera. The course will be dedicated to photography created with 35mm DSLR cameras.
- **Free:** This course is offered *free of charge* to Morgan County (Indiana) residents. It is hosted by the **Morgan County Soil & Water Conservation District** and funded through an **Arts Grant** from the **Community Foundation of Morgan County**.
